As part of your annual eye exam, our doctors highly recommend hexamine the retina and other internal structures of the eye. Dilatic eyes that enlarge the pupil (the black circle in the center of the cole takes 15 - 30 minutes for the drops to effectively dilate your eyes. I will experience increased discomfort from bright lights and sunlig when reading. On average, these symptoms last three to six hours with disposable sunshades at the completion of your eye exam.
